Function	Assignment	Channel Name	Channel Position	Remarks
Simplex operations	Ground to ground Air to ground Air to air	CC1	EFJ Radios: Zone 1 Channel 1 Tait Radios: Channel 1	Point to point only. Include in scan list and monitor whenever possible.
Repeater operation	Permitted for all needs when in range of repeater	LRL R42	EFJ Radios: Zone "LRL R42" Tait Radios: "LRL R42"	Repeated channel and usually linked to statewide system. Include in scan list and monitor whenever possible. Note that different repeaters channels will be needed when traveling. Refer to complete channel plans for further info
Nationwide calling channel	Used to establish contact	GUARD 1	EFJ Radios: GRD 1 Tait Radios: GRD 1	Used to establish contact with another station when you don't know what channel they are using. All stations should monitor Guard 1 whenever possible, using scan list. Move to another channel as soon as contact is established.
Alternate simplex	Use if CC1 is already in use	TAC 1	EFJ Radios: TAC 1 Tait Radios: TAC 1	Point to point only.
